EV Tax Credits Get Much Better In January 2024



Buyers of new and used clean vehicles will soon be able to transfer the credit amount to the point of sale, meaning they can theoretically drive out of a dealership or retail location with an EV for significantly less money than before—no waiting for money back in April or later.



Recurrent Auto studied 15,000 various EVs and learned that – outside of battery replacement recalls – only 1.5% of them have had their battery packs replaced.



EV vs. Gas Combustion Vehicles- Which Produce Fewer Emissions?

The average American owns as many as nine cars over the course of their lifetime. If all nine are gas powered, they'll add 693 metric tons of carbon dioxide to the atmosphere. If you buy 9 new electric cars, their lifetime carbon emissions will be 270 metric tons, or less



than 40% of what would have been created if you'd chosen to buy new ICE vehicles.

Tesla Installs its 50,000th Super Charger

With 50,000 Supercharging stalls and well over 5,000 stations globally, the network is the largest one among all fast-charging networks. In the coming years, Superchargers will be gradually more and more accessible to non-Tesla electric vehicles, through a Supercharging pilot program and the switch to Tesla's NACS charging connector in North America by other manufacturers.
