Hilton Will Install Up to 20,000 Tesla Universal Wall Connectors

Tesla Wall Connectors are charging infrastructure that will enable the recharging of both Tesla and non-Tesla electric vehicles. The company intends to deploy up to 20,000 units at 2,000 hotels in the United States, Canada and Mexico, to create the largest EV charging network within the hospitality industry.Installations will begin in early 2024.
