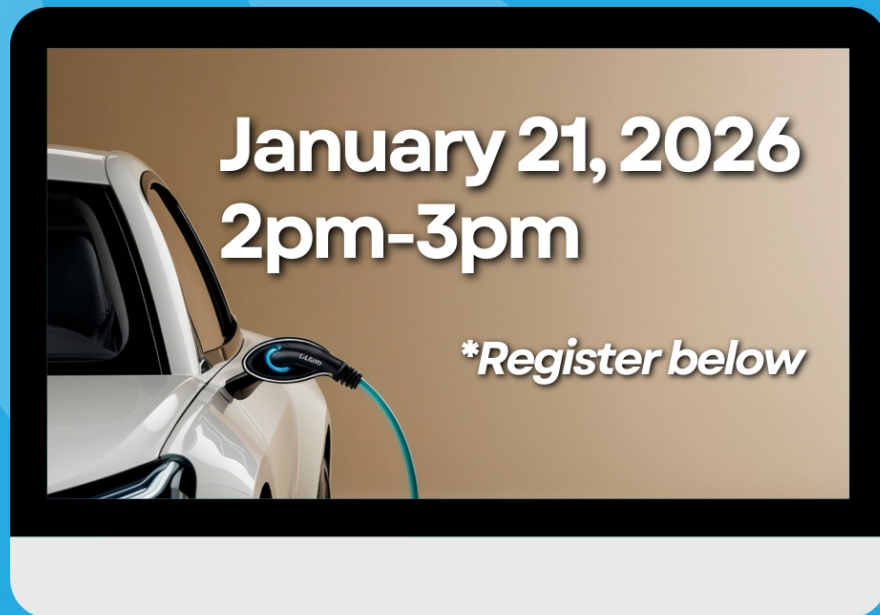

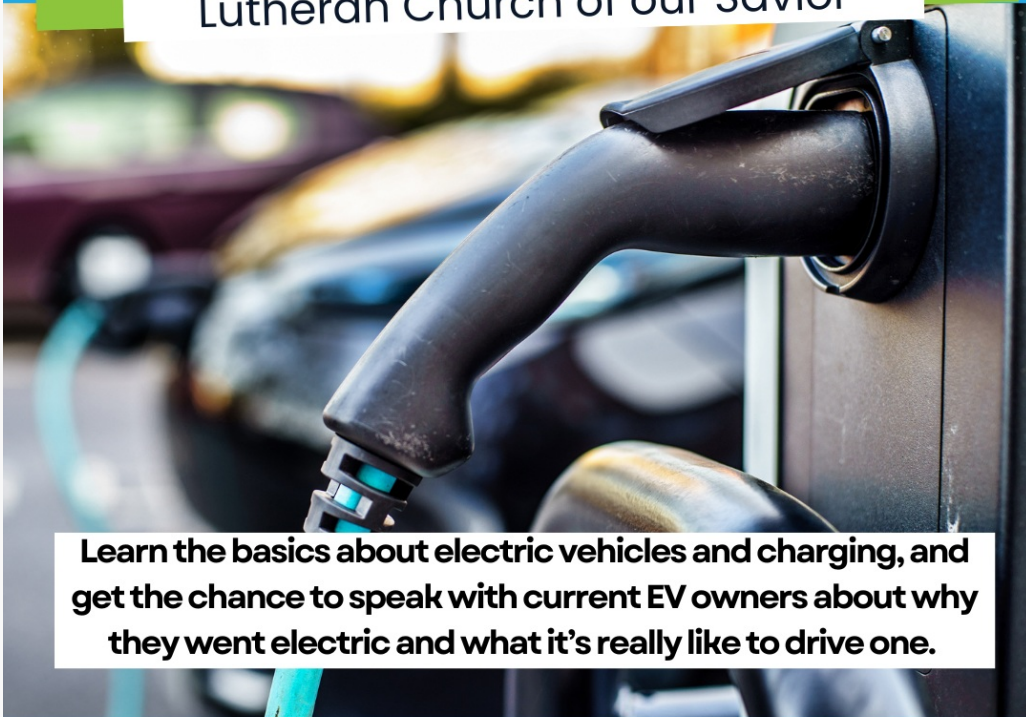

Walt Whitman High School

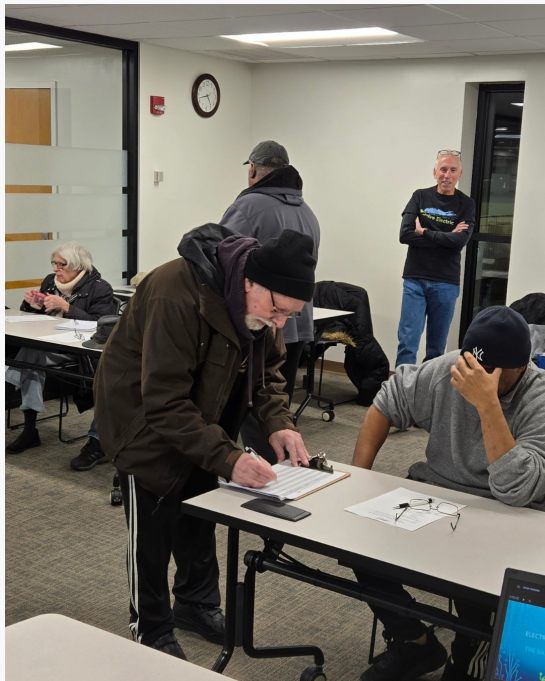
We were proud to join Walt Whitman High School's second annual Nonprofit Volunteer Fair,

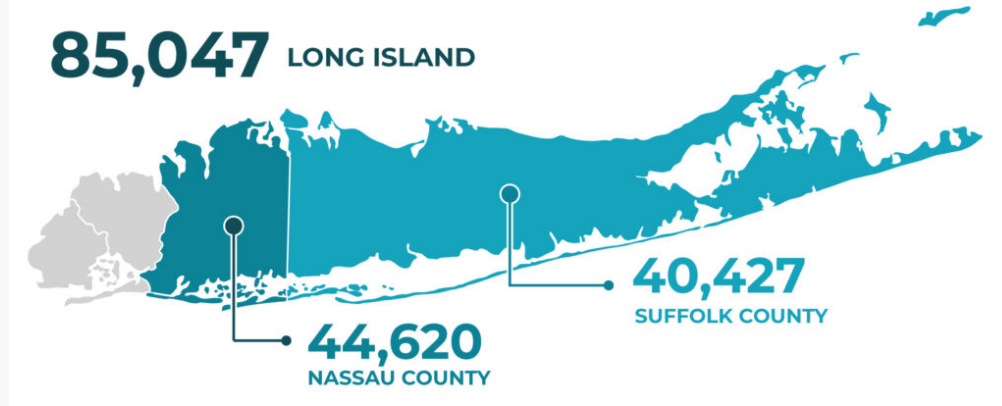

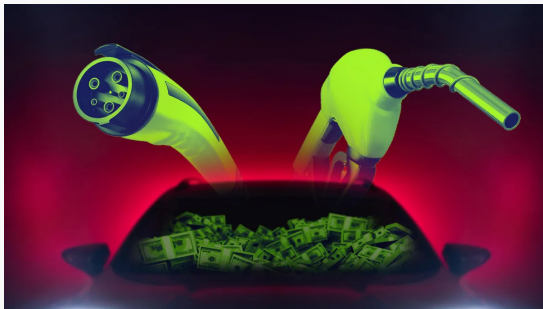

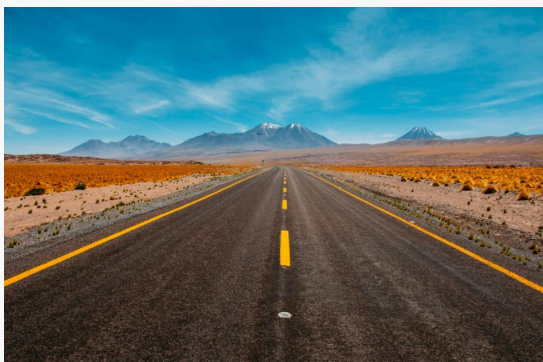
